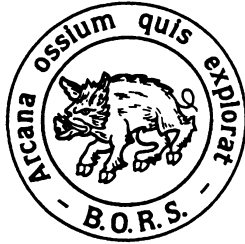

## BURSARIES

### How to apply and eligibility criteria

The British Orthopaedic Research Society is pleased to offer bursaries to fund registration, travel and accommodation for research students and technicians who are presenting abstracts at the Society's Meetings (the entitlement will be restricted to one bursary per annum).

The bursaries will be for a maximum of £100, and limited in number. Should the bursaries become oversubscribed, then the abstract score will be taken into account. Priority will be given to first time applicants and those who would otherwise have to self-fund their attendance.

### Eligibility criteria

**Award applicants must earn under £15,000 per annum**

Applicants will be requested to provide confirmation (download form at: [www.borsoc.org.uk/abstracts/BORS\\_abstract.htm](http://www.borsoc.org.uk/abstracts/BORS_abstract.htm)) that their earnings are less than £15,000 per annum, verified by their line manager and **faxed to the abstract administrators.**
